



InnerWireless Reports Record Quarter For Healthcare Orders; Total First-Quarter Hospital Bookings Exceed \$10 Million

Sales driven by hospitals' requirement for guaranteed point-of-care wireless coverage

RICHARDSON, Texas – May 1, 2008 – InnerWireless[®], Inc., the premier provider of in-building enterprise converged wireless solutions, today reported more than \$10 million in healthcare orders during the first three months of 2008, the company's largest-ever quarter from its healthcare segment. The record sales were fueled by hospitals' requirement for guaranteed in-building wireless coverage that assures access to mission- and life-critical applications everywhere inside the hospital, with an emphasis on point-of-care coverage.

Facilities including Childrens Hospital of Los Angeles; El Camino Hospital, Mountain View, Calif.; and the Baptist Health South Florida system were among the care providers that chose InnerWireless during the first quarter. Childrens and the Baptist Health South Florida hospitals are existing facilities; El Camino is a new 450,000-square-foot facility expected to open in the summer of 2009 with 300 licensed beds.

“We chose InnerWireless because they blanket our buildings with wireless coverage to the edge where patient care is delivered, and that's where we absolutely must have guaranteed wireless connectivity for mission- and life-critical applications,” said Steven Garske, Vice President and Chief Information Officer of Childrens Hospital Los Angeles. “The InnerWireless system's flexibility was also key to our decision because it can install easily into both our existing and new-construction facilities.
